Mr. Koroliuk was accepted into the Dance Department at the Zhytomyr College of Performing Arts and received a Diploma with Distinction. He continued his studies in Kyiv, Ukraine, at the National University of Culture and Performing Arts, Faculty of Drama and Choreography. His subjects included Choreography, Dance and Ethnography.

At the beginning of his career, Serhij performed as a member of "Lionok," the Polissian Song and Dance Ensemble, and the Bukovyna Song and Dance Ensemble, both professional state companies.

He is a former professor of Ukrainian Dance and Choreography at the College of Performing Arts in Chernivtsi and the Dance Director - Head Choreographer of the Bukovyna Song and Dance Ensemble under the umbrella of the Chernivtsi Philharmonic Organization

Mr. Koroliuk is now Artistic Director for the Pavlychenko Folklorique Ensemble in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan. As a result of his creativeness, exciting choreography and extensive knowledge, Serhij's services as a teacher, choreographer and adjudicator are in high demand across Canada.
